Mr Adamo opens the meeting centred on the experimentation already planned. Ms Träskelin underlines the satisfaction of the members of the Swedish delegation for receiving prominent information on the part of the key actors operating in Catania. In particular they appreciate the Italian interest in the European laws and regulations.

On this purpose Mr Adamo clarifies that as a rear light in the European context, Italy is trying to pay more attention to innovations, although it has often been interested in training initiatives addressed to unemployed people. Then he concentrates his attention on the newborn legislative measure. This latter foresees the creation of a fund collecting the sums the enterprises pay monthly in order to favour training initiatives addressed to employees and workers. Such funds will be controlled and handled by bilateral bodies (entrepreneurs and unions).

Then Ms Incardona explains the steps of the experimentation and the strategies that will be adopted to achieve the fixed objectives, she also shows the results of the analysis of the enterprises' and the training bodies' training needs in the province of Catania.

Such analysis is well expressed by Ms Spampinato, who gives detailed information about the economic field, as well as the key factors influencing both the enterprises and their training needs. As it is admitted that the items have been developed and discussed, the meeting closes at 1 p.m. (one in the afternoon).
