The participants meet in order to visit two training bodies in the Province of Catania: the representatives of CEFOP invite the Swedish delegation to visit the premises; then they describe their activities: on this purpose some trainees participating in the a vocational training course addressed to *computer workers* are interviewed.

Then the Swedish delegation visits ECAP: the responsible invites the Swedish delegation to visit the premises and describes their activities: he explains they have set up different vocational training courses, among which a vocational training course addressed to *beauticians* and another one addressed to *AUTOCAD programmers*. Some trainees participating in both courses are interviewed. The two visits give the possibility to deepen the *modus operandi* of the training bodies in Italy and to realise how successful the effects of vocational training can be on the beneficiaries.

The members of the Italian and Swedish delegations are both satisfied of the results of the meeting. In particular the Italian delegation hopes the Swedish partner, really skilled in the training field, can give useful suggestions / advice, aimed at improving what Italy has already realised.

As it is admitted that the items have been developed and discussed, the meeting closes at 6,30 p.m. (half past six in the afternoon).
